In June 1985, Higashikawa was declared the only "Town of Photography" in the world, with the aim of using international exchange and photography culture to open the town to the world and share the harmony between nature and culture uniquely found there.





Since being declared the Town of Photography 30 years ago, "The Culture Capital of Photography" Higashikawa aims to make the town a place of balance and harmony for the future. As the center of photo culture for people across the world, we organize this festival to encourage students to develop friendships through photo culture and promote international understanding.

Outline for the festival


We are looking for works (a series of photos) from the countries and areas listed below, where we currently have established international exchanges. The selection will be held in each country and area. The 11 selected schools from overseas (one school per country and area) and 3 selected schools from Japan will participate in the festival (held in the "Town of Photography" Higashikawa).



<11 school participants from overseas





Application requirements

Please submit a team with three students enrolled in a Japanese high school or its educational equivalent.

- · Students from either full and part-time courses are acceptable.
- Students who do not belong to a photography club can still apply if they make a team.

When you apply, please choose a teacher to participate with students and obtain consent from your principal to participate in the festival.

- The teacher should be an advisor for the photography club if the club participates. If the team does not belong to a photography club, the teacher should be available to accompany the team during the festival.
- · Generally, all participants of the team should come from the same school. If you wish to make a team of students from different schools, please contact us.

This year's theme

This year's theme is "The pride of my town"

Rules for application

- 1)Only digital photos will be accepted.
- 2)Only unreleased works(works which have not won a prize in any other competitions) will be accepted. After the participant selection, if the organizer discovers there is an already released or similar work in the submitted works, permission to participate may be withdrawn).
- 3One team per school can apply for the competition. More than one team will not be accepted.
- 4) Please submit a series of 6 photos for consideration.
- ⑤Please submit the works by e-mail. Only works in JPEG format and resolutions higher than 6 megapixels will be accepted. If the works have large file sizes, please send them through reliable file hosting services.
- ⑥File names should be renamed numbers only. (Example: "#1", "#2", "#3", etc.).
- Please complete the "Application form" with the signature of the principal to allow students to participate in the festival. The application forms should be converted to PDF format and submitted with the works by e-mail.
- ® Any submitted works may be exhibited in exhibitions held by the organizer, used for printings and publications, and uploaded on the website without any charge.

Application deadline Applications must be received by 5pm on May 20 (Fri), 2016 (Japan Standard Time).

Selection method

Submitted works are assessed by a panel of judges for each country and area, and they will make the final selection of participants for the festival.

Result announcement

- 1) Preliminary selection is held in late May.
- ②The selected schools will be announced early in June on the website and contacted directly. We inform the schools which is not selected, too.
- 3 Plaques and award certificates will be sent to the selected schools.
- (4) The submitted works will be exhibited in the main venue (Hokko Gakuen) during the festival.

Expenses

The festival committee is responsible for travel expenses from the nearest airport to Higashikawa and the accommodations for participants (three students and a teacher).

All meals during the festival are also provided by the organizer.





11 high schools from overseas and 3 schools in Japan gather in Higashikawa, the "Town of Photography" and take photos of beautiful scenery around the town.

E Contents of the festival

Each team will participate in 3 photo sessions based on themes and categories specific to the place and time. Cameras and memory cards to be used will be provided by the organizer.)

After photo sessions, each team will select a series of 6 photos as well as 2 photos per person, all of which will be titled.

Computers and printers will be provided by the organizer.

F Judging

Judges will be consisted of 7 people, 2 from overseas and 5 from Japan, who are photographers and other specialists in the field.
