Since being declared the Town of Photography about 30 years ago, "The Culture Capital of Photography," Higashikawa, aims grow as a town with a good balance of nature and culture. As the center of photo culture for people across the world, we organize this festival to encourage students to develop friendships through photo culture and to promote international understanding.

Outline for the festival

We are looking for works (a series of photos) from the countries and areas listed below, where we currently have established international exchanges. The selection will be held in each country and area. The 21 selected schools from overseas (one school per country and area) and 3 selected schools from Japan will participate in the festival (held in the "Town of Photography," Higashikawa).
