Purpose of the Festival

Higashikawa Town, the “Cultural Capital of Photography,” has been aiming for a future in harmony between the town’s nature and culture for 35 years since it was declared a Town of Photography. Higashikawa Town, as the center of photography culture, has been holding the International High School Students’ Photo Festival Exchange to connect photography culture with the people of the world, with the aim of deepening conversation, expanding the circle of friendship, and wishing for the world peace through photography culture.

Outline for the festival

We are looking for works (a series of photos) from the countries and areas listed below, where we currently have established international exchanges. The selection will be held in each country and area. The selected schools from overseas and schools from Japan will participate in the festival.

Preliminary Selection of the International High School Students' Photo Festival Exchange

A Eligibility

- Submit a team of three students enrolled in high school or other educational institution equivalent to Japanese high school.
 - ・ There should be one accompanying teacher who takes part as an advisor.
 - ・ Only one team per school may apply for the competition. More than one team will not be accepted.
- The students must have an interest in international exchange through photography with other participants from foreign countries or regions.

C Rules for Application

- ① Only digital photos will be accepted.
- ② Only unpublished photos will be accepted (photos which have not been awarded a prize in another contest). If after the school selection process, the committee finds out one or more photos within the submitted works have been published, or are too similar to published works, permission to participate may be withdrawn)
- ③ One team per school can apply for the competition. More than one team will not be accepted.
- ④ Submit a series of 6 photos.
- ⑤ The submitted images must taken in RGB mode, JPEG file format, over 1024 pixel size (long side of rectangle), over 72pixel per inch.
- ⑥ Submit the works by e-mail. If the works have large file sizes, please send them through reliable file hosting services.
- ⑦ File names should be renamed with numbers. (Example: "#1", "#2", "#3", etc.)
- ⑧ Complete the “Application form” with the signature of the principal as permission to participate in the festival. The application forms should be converted to PDF format and submitted with the works by e-mail.
- ⑨ Please note that any submitted works will be exhibited in exhibitions held by the organizer, used for printings and publications, and uploaded on the website without compensation.

Submitted works will be assessed by a panel of judges for each country and area, and they will make the final selection of participants for the festival.

G Result Announcement

- ① The Preliminary selection will be held in late June.
- ② The Executive Committee will announce the results on Friday, July 30th on the website, and also contact all entrants by email.
- ③ Selected schools will be presented with a plaque and a certificate.
- ④ All submitted works will be displayed at the main venue of International High School Students' Photo Festival Exchange during the holding period.

- ②The submitted photos must not have been previously publicly shown or published and may not have placed in any previous competitions.
- ③The submitted images must taken in RGB mode, JPEG file format, over 1024 pixel size (long side of rectangle), over 72pixel per inch.
- ④The organizer accepts submissions by email. Please send them to both the organizer and coordinator. The entrants may send the images through reliable file hosting services if the size of the images is too large.
- ⑤The name of the image files must be numbered: for example, #1, #2.
- ⑥The entrants must fill out the application form and send it in PDF format along with the submitted images to the organizer. The signature of the principal is essential.
- ⑦Please note that all submitted images will be shown on our website, exhibited at exhibitions, and used for publications.
